### Cancer Services Project (CSP) of Albany County

The following is a summary of a presentation given by Kathy DiCaprio, Out Reach Manager for the Cancer Services Project of Albany County to the Rotary Club of Cohoes on November 26, 2008.

Kathy stated that the purpose of her presentation was to explain what CSP was, what services they provide and who are eligible to receive these services.

CSP of Albany County is a Cancer Service Program Partner as part of the New York State Department of Health's Cancer Screening Program. We provide uninsured or underinsured men and women with: breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screening. They are funded by the NYS Department of Health, and the US Center for Disease Control. This program has been providing these services for 14 years. CSP of Albany County is located at 260 Osborne Road with the American Cancer Society. As of April 1, 2008 this program is available in every county in the State of New York.

Uninsured means a patient has no health insurance. Underinsured means that a patient has some health insurance but the insurance they have does not cover cancer screening, or insufficient frequency (e.g. only every other year), or they may have a very high co-pay. Patient's income must not exceed 250% of poverty level income.

Kathy explained that if cancer is found as part of the screening services that they provide, that CSP will pay for treatment. They do not cover screening for prostate cancer, but they do pay for treating it.

CSP offers many other services as well including: driving patients to and from treatments, free wigs, membership in support groups, and a point of contact for obtaining supplies for patients.

Kathy passed out three handouts: <u>Healthy Living Partnerships</u>, <u>Cancer Screening Program - Facts for Providers</u>, and Albany County Providers.
