Program: Julie Defruscio - Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation

Julie Defruscio and her 10 year old daughter Nickie talked to the club about Juvenile Diabetes. Julie focused on Type 1 Diabetes. She explained that some children have a latent condition, that when triggered results in permanent destruction of cells in the pancreas that produce insulin. Therefore, diet and exercise alone are not sufficient to control this condition. Insulin must be taken. The invention of insulin pumps makes life much easier for those who have this disease. Nickie Defruscio told members of the club what her life is like with Type 1 Diabetes. Julie gave a tee shirt to the club. Ed Tremblay responded on behalf of the club and presented the Award to Julie.
