Sales at the <u>Fall Festival</u> consisted of \$157.00 from Money Bear tickets, \$60.00 from ornaments and \$130.00 from mugs.

Program:

Deborah Canzano provided the club with an update on what is going on at the Cohoes Public Library. During the summer 2008 they offered many programs including: Storyline, and Paws for Reading (children read books to dogs). They had 49 children complete the summer program in which they read 919 books.

The Library also provides computer classes in which they teach people how to use e-mail, and establish an e-mail account. With so many businesses only accepting job applications on line, it is important that people looking for work have these skills.

Debby explained that they received grants that allowed them to: purchase three new notebook computers and software, make needed improvements to their building, provide training to librarians to make them consumer advocates, and to purchase 22 laminated copies of pictures of famous Americans, and books about liberty.

She also showed the club several historical documents that the Library owns including: photographs of students at Cohoes High School from the 1940's and 1950's, the May 1898 muster roll from Company B of Cohoes, and 1910 to 1911 log books from the Cohoes Hospital.

Linda Trembley responded on behalf of the club.
