RI Foundation and Other Issues

Richard Hodge began his remarks be explaining that he is the person who sends out the Tool Box, and the Events e-mail for District 7190.

District 7190:

District 7190 has lost two clubs and currently includes 44 clubs and 1, 486 members.

RI Foundation:

- The objectives of the new regulations for the RI Foundation were explained at the May 29, 2009 Regional RI Foundation Seminar: simplify foundation processes, insure that programs are consistent with the mission of the RI Foundation, focus efforts of Rotarians where they are needed most, transfer more decision making to the district level and gain greater understanding of RI and Rotary image.
- On the death of a club member, any points that the member had accrued revert to RI.
- Now you can transfer points in increments of 100.
- 50% of district designated funds come back to the district.
- If you want to do a matching grant, you have to pay costs up front and send a bill to RI
 to be reimbursed.
- The Rotary Club of Cohoes paid its pledge for Polio and for the RI Foundation.
