Discipline:

- 1 <u>Focus on the Wildly Important</u>: A wildly important goal (WIG) must be achieved.
- 2 <u>Act on the Lead Measures</u>: Invest your energy in the few activities that have the most impact on the WIG.
- 3. <u>Keep a Compelling Scoreboard</u>: Keep track of the progress that is being made toward achieving the WIG.
- <u>Create a Cadence of Accountability with</u> <u>Weekly Meetings</u>: Meet regularly and frequently to account to each other for commitments.
