## **Brian Tilley**

### Long-Term Care Insurance



#### Brian Tilley and Ed Tremblay

Brain A. Tilley, Northeast Zone Director for Long-Term Care Insurance for the New York Life Insurance Company, spoke to our Rotary Club about long-term care insurance. As Northeast Zone Director, Brian is a resource for over 1,000 insurance agents in New England and parts of New York State.

Most people today live longer and will need care as they get older. Long-term care is much more than care that patients receive in a nursing home. In fact, 80% of claims are for non nursing home related services.

Many more people want to stay at home. This is usually where the <u>Continuum of Care</u> occurs. A typical progression of increasing level of care is as follows:

- Life Line
- Meals on Wheels
- A companion 2 or 3 times a week
- Personal hygiene
- Adult day care

Brian explained that services similar to the ones stated above kept his mother in her home for six years.

Most of the services referred to above are either not covered by Medicaid, or are covered on only to a minimum degree.

Most of the time long-term care insurance is purchased by children or siblings of the insured. Most people also overestimated the cost of long-term care insurance. However it is best to buy it when you are young. There are tax deductions for long-term care insurance, and quality discounts are available. In addition, the health care proposal that President Obama is recommending does not include time long-term care.

Brian also gave members of the club a copy of <u>A Shopper's guide to Long-Term Care</u> <u>Insurance</u>, from the National Associating of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).
