## What LinguaLinx Is About!

David Smith, President of LinguaLinx, spoke to the Rotary Club of Cohoes regarding his company. He majored in Russian in College, after which he worked as a Russian translator. This resulted in the founding of LinguaLinx in 2002.

LinguaLinx is a full service language translation company. Their services however are not just limited to translating documents. They provide interpreter services to companies as well. For example, they provide such services to Ellis Hospital. They also review documents and other information for companies to ensure that they are not offensive to other cultures. In addition, they provide advice to companies how to structure their English documents so that they can be more easily translated into other languages.

David stated that LinguaLinx is a multi million dollar business. They currently employ 43 people, and plan to employ 50 by the end of 2009. In August 2008 Inc. Magazine ranked LinguaLinx 311of the 500 fastest growing private Companies in the US. LinguaLinx has reduced their operating costs by moving its headquarters to upstate NY. This allows them to hire quality talent from local colleges in the area and still be competitive in their marketplace. Their headquarters is 122 Remsen Street in Cohoes, in a building that has been named the LinguaLinx Building.

One of the things they would like to have is a street fest on Remsen Street.

Jessica Close, Vice President of Operations for LinguaLinx also spoke. She stated that the NYS Empire Zone Program has been a very appealing option for businesses. She also stated that Cohoes provides them with a very business friendly environment to do business in.
