### **Cohoes Relays**

Will Hebert spoke to our club about <u>Cohoes Relays</u>, and the <u>Cohoes High School Track Club</u>. Cohoes Relays is an organization that coordinates an annual track and cross country meet for Section II teams in Cohoes on the last Saturday in April each year. This year it will be April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

These efforts are paying dividends because the number participants is increasing. The following comparison statistics show growth between 2005/6 and 2007/8:

Outdoor track	25	101	
Cross country	14	35	
Indoor Track	n/a	60	

Money to support this effort is raised through: business sponsors, in-kind and cash donations, and concession stands at meets. Funds raised are used to purchase awards given (including Track Spirit Awards for graduates) and team clothing.

These efforts are paying dividends because the number of teams and participants is increasing. The following comparison statistics show growth of this annual event between 2004 and 8:

2008	35	3,000

One of the significant aspects of these meets is that they are held in less time than anywhere else. The meet begins at 9:00 AM and is over by 3: 00 PM.
