#### Club Business:

- Ed Tremblay explained that the mugs for 2009 have a picture of the Half Moon on them. A replica of Henry Hudson's Half Moon was on exhibit at Van Schaick Pond in Cohoes from 1910 to 1931. These mugs will sell for \$6.00. He also explained that the 2009 Christmas ornament will have the same picture on them and will sell for \$15.00.
- The club membership agreed to a proposal to sell the 2008 Christmas Ornament (picture of City Hall on it) and a 2009 mug for a package price of \$15.00 at Explore Cohoes.

#### Rotary's Wheel Emblem:

A wheel has been the symbol of Rotary since our earliest days. The first design was made by Chicago Rotarian Montague Bear, an engraver who drew a simple wagon wheel, with a few lines to show dust and motion. The wheel was said to illustrate "Civilization and Movement."

Most of the early clubs had some form of wagon wheel on their publications and letterheads. Finally, in 1922, it was decided that all Rotary clubs should adopt a single design as the exclusive emblem of Rotarians. Thus, in 1923, the present gear wheel, with 24 cogs and six spokes was adopted by the "Rotary International Association."

A group of engineers advised that the geared wheel was mechanically unsound and would not work without a "keyway" in the center of the gear to attach it to a power shaft. So, in 1923 the keyway was added and the design which we now know was formally adopted as the official Rotary International emblem.
