Rotary's Wheel Emblem:

A wheel has been the symbol of Rotary since our earliest days. The first design was made by Chicago Rotarian Montague Bear, an engraver who drew a simple wagon wheel, with a few lines to show dust and motion. The wheel was said to illustrate "Civilization and Movement."

Most of the early clubs had some form of wagon wheel on their publications and letterheads. Finally, in 1922, it was decided that all Rotary clubs should adopt a single design as the exclusive emblem of Rotarians. Thus, in 1923, the present gear wheel, with 24 cogs and six spokes was adopted by the "Rotary International Association."

A group of engineers advised that the geared wheel was mechanically unsound and would not work without a "keyway" in the center of the gear to attach it to a power shaft. So, in 1923 the keyway was added and the design which we now know was formally adopted as the official Rotary International emblem.

Salvation Army Receives 2008/9 Award

On August 5th, 2009, Major Lydia Pearson, Director and Albany Area Coordinator for the Salvation accepted a 2008/9 Award from The Rotary Club of Cohoes.

Lydia Pearson began her talk by explaining that the Salvation Army is in the process of reevaluating how services in Cohoes will be provided. She explained that their building in Cohoes which currently holds the soup kitchen and food pantry will be sold. Their challenge is how they can provide these services in Cohoes from our facility in Albany.

Major Pearson explained that the Vineyard Church will allow the Salvation Army to use their facility for a food pantry when it becomes available. They are currently looking for temporary space until the facility is ready.

Major Person reiterated that the Salvation Army is not leaving Cohoes. Rather they are trying to determine how to provide services in Cohoes without owning a building there.
