- \*Remember through all service events to keep the Rotary name out there through signs, wearing of pins, potentially buying shirts.
- Work with students on projects for Global Youth Service Day held in May.

  Opportunities exist to chaperone students and/or work side by side with them to model. Will be looking for businesses that would like assistance for the day cleaning, etc. Julie DeFruscio and Peg O'Shea will attend organizational meeting.
- Look for ongoing activities within the community to support (i.e. food drives, "Soup-er bowl")
- See if Veterans' groups (i.e. Cohoes Memorial, Cohoes Remembers, etc.) need assistance with activities
- See if there are smaller projects in which Rotary can provide assistance at Cohoes Community Center, Senior Center, Cohoes Music Hall, etc..
- Holiday Help
- Throughout the year inform the schools of projects so students can sign up (provide opportunities for community service). This is a requirement for students from Participation in Government a 12<sup>th</sup> grade class.
- Colin to talk to students at the high school regarding his work with the regional food bank.
- **4** Adopt a family.
- Reach out to those affected by disasters such as the earthquake in Haiti, providing shelter boxes etc.
