Shelterbox USA in Haiti

Jack Faddigan (Latham) explained the role that Shelter Box is having in Haiti. Shelter Box already has three teams there, and are working with the nineteen Rotary Club in Haiti.

Jack explained that more than 3,300 Shelter Boxes have been committed so far, enough to help up to 33,000 people.

A temporary hospital made of Shelterbox tents has been set up next to the Port-au-Prince airport.

Jack also explained that in the past two to three years, District 7190 has raised money for sixty to seventy boxes.

He concluded his remarks by explaining that people want to
