Definition of Rotary:

In 1976 the Rotary International Board of Directors was interested in creating a concise definition of the fundamental aspects of Rotary. They turned to the three men who were then serving on Rotary's Public Relations Committee and requested that a one-sentence definition of Rotary be prepared. After numerous drafts, the committee presented this definition, which has been used ever since in various Rotary publications:

Rotary is an organization of business and professional persons united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations and help build goodwill and peace in the world.

Tom Mullins, history teacher at Cohoes Middle School, and coach of the Cohoes High School Mock Trial team, spoke to our club about the experiences that students have in Mock Trial. Members of the team in attendance were: Sonjnetta Searight, Christina Kelley, Kimberly Hansen and Jordan Dedrick. Sonjnetta Cooper-Searight and Florence Wagar, assistants to Tom Mullins, were also in attendance.

What is Mock Trial?

Mock Trial is an extracurricular program in which students participate in imitation trials to learn new skills and compete with each other. Tom Mullins explained that, in government class, students learn about the law. In Mock Trial, they learn how to apply it.

2010 Competition:

In this year's competition, the Mock Trial team from Cohoes was very close to winning the championship. They lost by only one point!

About the Students:

Sonjnetta Searight, Kim Hansen and Florence Wagar were attorneys. Sonjnetta is an excellent attorney. She does a thorough job in researching the case being argued. Kim Hansen is very effective at picking up on facts and using them either for or against a witness. Christina Kelley is an excellent expert witness. She can take a difficult topic and simplify it so the jury can understand the main points being made. Jordan Dedrick is excellent at a multi-tasking, and does a great job.
