Why Attendance at Weekly Meetings Is Important By Chuck Ries

I have been a member of the Cohoes Rotary Club since 1970. During my forty years, I have realized how important it is to attend as many weekly meetings as possible. This allows me to maintain personal contact with fellow Rotarians and their guests, as well as keep abreast of various assundry local and international projects and not-for-profit organizations that we attempt to support. Attending meetings allows me to make and maintain friendships with a broad spectrum of people that I would not otherwise have an opportunity to meet. During my years in Rotary, I have actually considered some of the older members to be mentors.

I have a very busy legal practice that requires a great deal of attention, both in handling transactional matters for clients as well as court appearances. Despite my busy schedule, I attempt to organize my appointments so that I can set aside the time to attend Rotary meetings. My staff is aware of this and do their best to help me in this regard. There are times when the rush of business will not allow me to attend meetings and times that I have to leave a meeting early.

Failure to make meetings has a financial impact upon the club. We must pay for a minimum number of lunches and if attendance is low, it costs the club money.
