The Rotary Foundation Event has been rescheduled for December 7th. The program will be a preview performance of this year's holiday show, "A Wonderful Life." The program will include hors d'oeuvres and a silent auction at 5:30 and the show will begin at 7:00. A Paul Harris Award presentation will take place during intermission. The goal is to have 300 Rotarians attend the event.

The Les Miserables production will include both adults and children. Nineteen different schools will be represented with student cast members.

The Music Hall has received a grant from Stewart's Shops for an anti-bullying tour.

The Group Study Exchange program has been established for the country of Japan. A group of Japanese citizens will be visiting the area in late April through mid May. They will attend the District Conference in Lake George. The District 7190 team interview process has started. There have been 4 candidates for team leader. The team will consist of 1 Rotarian (team leader) and 4 non-Rotarians between the ages of 25-40. They will travel to Japan for 4 weeks during the month of March. The district is in the process of organizing a team to Brazil in 2013.
