

Did you know that besides books . . .

- The Library has four experienced staff ready to help you.
- The Library lends out Nook eReaders, DVDs, Books on CD, pre-loaded MP3 players, PS2 Games, and fishing rods. Yes, fishing rods.
- The Library has free public Wi-Fi, a copier, scanner, fax machine, 10 public access computers loaded with Microsoft Office 2010 and three different web browsers, and a printer.
- Your Library card provides you with access to the resources of the 29 libraries in the Upper Hudson Library System, Overdrive downloadable ebooks and audiobooks, and databases such as JobNow!
- The Library has a website,
 - www.cohoespubliclibrary.org, a Facebook page, www.facebook.com/cohoespublicLibrary, and a Twitter account @cohoespubliclibrary.
- The Library offers a monthly movie night featuring a popular movie - and admission is free!
- The Library has 3 local newspapers and 3 national newspapers for reading as well as over 50 different periodicals including Consumer Reports, Real Simple, and the Economists.
- The Library offers a Summer Read program for children that promotes learning, literacy, and a love for reading.
 - The Library hosts a therapy dog for children to read to every second and forth Saturday of the month (call ahead).
- The Library hosts adult programming, a mystery book club, discussions with noted authors, and a weekly knitting club.
- The Library offers public meeting room space.
