Program: Cohoes Rotary member Robert Van Alstine wrote a book titled The Prince of Freedom on the life of J. Jaroslav Sustar. He had Mr. Sustar's widow Joyce Sustar Martucci at the meeting with him. Born in 1908, Sustar was a prominent Nazi resister in his native Czechoslovakia. He was a pilot and parachutist in the 1920s and graduated from the Czech Military Academy in 1937. His assignment was to sabotage the Nazi war effort. He was caught, jailed and sentenced to death. He escaped and eventually came to the United States in 1948. He became a news analyst for radio and television. He founded the Allegheny Academy, a secondary school in Gibsonia, PA. He became deputy director of the International Studies Institute at Westminster College in New Wilmington, PA. He ended his career working for the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The book was a private printing. If you are interested in reading a copy of the book you may borrow one from Bob.
