Program:

Dave Koshnick, President, Choose Cohoes for Art, gave some history of the origins of the organization. Choose Cohoes for Art started as the Arts Committee under the Cohoes Local Development Corporation. In 2018, Choose Cohoes for Art incorporated as a 501c3. The first Artist Showcase was held in 2011 in a storefront on Remsen Street. The next five years the Artist Showcase was held at The Venue (formerly St. Joseph's Church in Cohoes). In 2014 and 2015 the Moonglow Gala was held in conjunction with the Artist Showcase. The Liz Toch Scholarship was established in 2014 for students planning to attend art school. It was then expanded to support anyone in the creative arts. Last year \$1,000 was awarded to Art for Vets who used the donation to purchase art supplies. In recent years, the Artist Showcase has been held in the Cohoes Music Hall, except for 2020, which was a virtual showcase. Fred Neudoerffer is the curator of the Artist Showcase. The members of the group are looking forward to an in-person Artist Showcase this year. Choose Cohoes for Art has a website and a Facebook page. The group is looking to expand their Board beyond members who are artists.
