We have received our IRS letter of determination that authorizes the MWSF as a 501 (c) 3 tax-exempt organization, so your donation is fully tax deductible. We hope that the following paragraphs will bring into focus what our foundation has brought and hopes to bring to the MWS community.

The board of directors is extremely proud of our first Family Conference that was held at Kansas City Medical Center at the end of June 2014. We had over 270 people attend from across the USA and also from Canada, England, France, Chile and Norway! Drs. Mowat and Wilson, from Australia, were our keynote speakers. What an emotional and inspiring weekend!

We have also started our website, [www.mowat-wilson.org](http://www.mowat-wilson.org), to provide the Mowat-Wilson Syndrome community with information, resources and support. The website is also a resource for the medical community and the community at-large. Awareness and diagnosis of the syndrome is paramount because it is so rare and is a recently named syndrome (1998).

We are in the process of developing a medical advisory committee to help us decide what research the foundation can help to fund to aid our MWS community. Mowat-Wilson Syndrome has many areas of need including management of Hirshsprungs' Disease, seizure disorders, intellectual and developmental delays, and non-verbal communication issues.

We have many ideas for the future and we thank you so much for supporting our foundation. We have accomplished so much in less than a year, but we know there is so much more to be done.
