The first shovel of soil was turned in Rome, NY marking
The start of the Erie Canal construction.

Eight years later the canal opened from Albany to Buffalo.
Lock 13 in Cohoes (now under Bedford St.) is the closer one in the image.

The lock in the distance is Lock 14
(off of Standish St. behind Cohoes Bowl).

The bridge is at High Street.
